



Ogilvie School Campus Cost of the School Day Action Statement

At Ogilvie School Campus we are committed to ensuring that all children and young people have access to rich and diverse learning experiences by removing any poverty related barriers to learning. See below for more information on this:

- Eating at School: Each pupil at our school is entitled to a free meal at lunch. Because of the nature of our school, pupils are not required to pay anything towards this. Our pupils also receive breakfast and snack daily with no additional cost to parents/carers. Parents/Carers are not asked to send any contributions to aid in the purchasing of any additional resources for additional snacks, Home Economics etc.
- **Resources:** Our pupils are not required to provide any school supplies; we provide all the necessary equipment for pupils to learn at school. Pupils can be provided with a PE kit if necessary. If required, we provide pupils with the necessary equipment for Outdoor Learning, such as appropriate footwear. For Wider Achievement activities, such as Bikeability we provide pupils with bicycles, including adapted bikes. Young people take part in lessons to develop skills for life and work, including independent living skills. All materials required for this will be supplied for each young person to take part.
- Uniform: Our school uniform is a purple or black polo shirt or sweat shirt. Our school does not require pupils to have their uniform tops embroidered and allow any black or grey bottoms.
 Our school hold extras in our cupboards in case a pupil requires uniform pieces while at school.
- **Travel:** Each of our pupils receive free transport to and from school daily provided by West Lothian Council. When going on trips during school which require transport, the cost of travel is covered by our school.













- **Trips:** Trips taken throughout the school year are covered through school funds and parent council contributions.
- Events: School events are free to all pupils. Refreshments will be provided at all family engagement events. Where possible we try to provide transport to events for those families who need it. For occasions which require resources, for example our family cooking sessions, we will provide materials to those families who require them.
- **Fund-raising Events:** The school considers the number of charity/fundraising events in the school year and ensures a spread across the calendar. No financial charges are made for any event.
- **Participatory Budgeting**: The Pupil Council decided that the Pupil Equity Funding should be used for subsidy or full payment to any pupil where there is a difficulty in meeting the cost of school camp, thereby ensuring that no pupil misses out on the opportunity to participate.
