Ogilvie School Campus has been allocated £115,000 of Pupil Equity Funding.

This session our key priorities are:

- We will work closely with pupils and families to provide support and remove barriers to learning by working alongside our CAMHs colleagues.
- We will continue to employ additional APSW's to support targeted pupils. This is providing direct support to pupils who require intensive strategies to help them access their education and wider opportunities beyond the classroom.
